 - o LSD, Mushroom; increase

 - Oxy has come down in the past 7 months
- New Neuro-Cogntive testing being done, RBANS (Repeatable Battery for the Assessment of Neuropsychological Status)
 - Testing memory
 - Cognitive disorders present among teens
 - Permanent damage due to prolonged use of drugs and alcohol on a prematurely developed brain
